PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Students will gain skills in first year apprenticeship Industrial Mechanic as well as earn a Pre-Employment Industrial Mechanic Certificate from Red Deer Polytechnic. Training takes place in a post secondary setting by Journeyperson instructors.

A DAY IN THE LIFE

Students will attend full-time technical training classes at Red Deer Polytechnic in semester two of their Grade 11 or Grade 12 year. Program start date is March- June in which technical training classes will run six hours a day for twelve weeks Monday through Friday.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION - WHY DUAL CREDIT PRE-EMPLOYMENT?

If you like doing precise work that is varied and challenging, this program might be for you. In order to be eligible, you must have a minimum of 65 credits completed, including the following recommended courses:

Minimum 16 years of age in Grades 11 or 12

- Successfully completed TEC 1000 and/or WLD 1167 at Olds College
- On track for high school graduation
- Have completed at a minimum English 20-2, Math 20-3 and Science 10
- Any related CTS/TMT cluster courses
- Students must have completed HCS 3000
- Mature, punctual and reliable with a strong work ethic and willingness to learn. Your school's endorsement is needed in these areas.

- Able to commit to the duration of the program and attend all classes across the 12 weeks. No holidays can be taken.
- Have transportation to Red Deer Polytechnic
- CSA approved steel-toed boots and safety glasses. (subject to change)
- Students will also require the recommendation from their high school regarding attendance and efforts in class. Students must have commitment to this level of learning and be on-track to graduate high school with the strongest diploma possible.
